

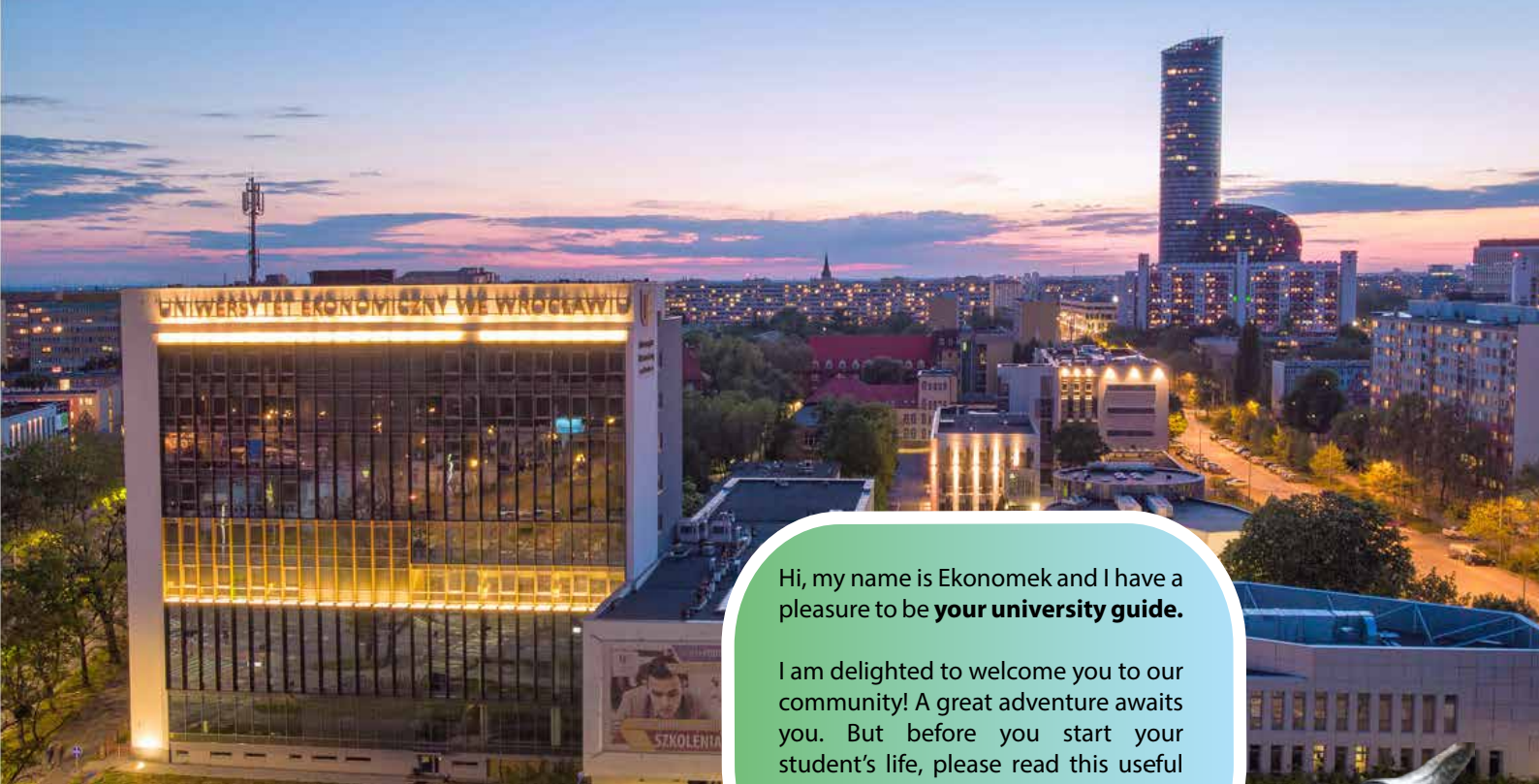

## WELCOME TO THE WROCLAW UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS AND BUSINESS (UEW)

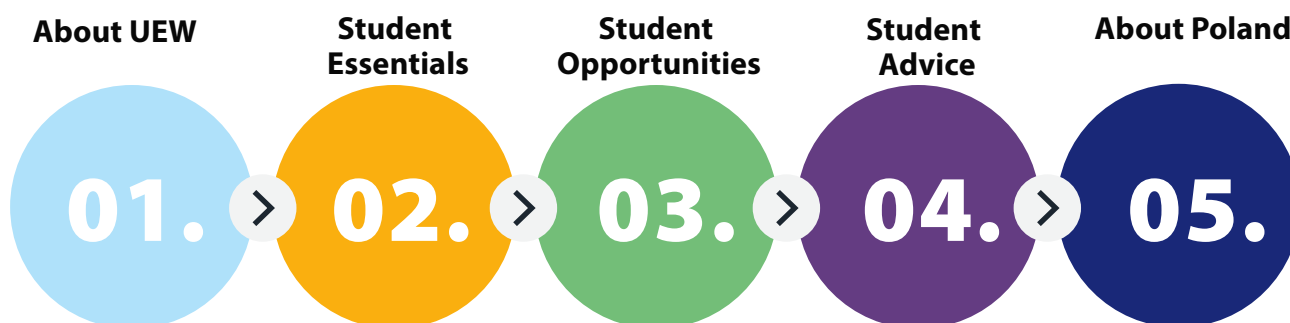
We are delighted that you will join our academic community. We want to put every effort into making your stay unforgettable and full of experiences.

# STUDENT ID CARD

## WHERE CAN YOU GET YOUR STUDENT ID CARD?

The Student ID Card can be collected in person from the Dean's Office (**Building A, room 134 for programs in English**), at the beginning of the semester. The Student ID Card is valid for one semester. After it expires, you need to go to the Dean's Office and extend its validity.

## WHEN DO YOU NEED YOUR STUDENT ID CARD?

- at the library (in order to enter and borrow books, hire the cabin)
- during the examination session
- in the places where you can use student discounts (public transport, museums, etc.)

We recommend having it with you while being at the University.



Remember that with your Student ID Card you are provided with discounts for public transport and Polish State Railways (cheaper tickets).

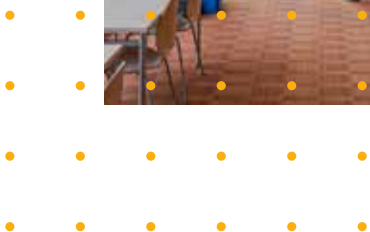


## WHERE CAN YOU GET YOUR STUDENT LIBRARY CARD?

## WEBMAIL

All students have access to the University e-mail which is used for communication (and is the only official form of it). Access to e-mail is via WWW and it also gives you access to other services of the Microsoft 365 system, such as Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and OneNote Online (browser-based), calendars and contacts, OneDrive, MS Teams, and many others. In order to use it, you must log in with your e-mail address and password. We remind you about the recommended change of the password which you received from the University.

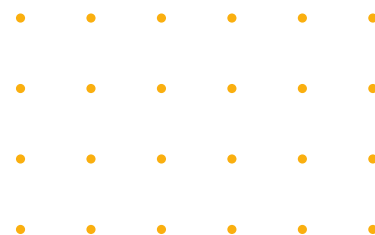
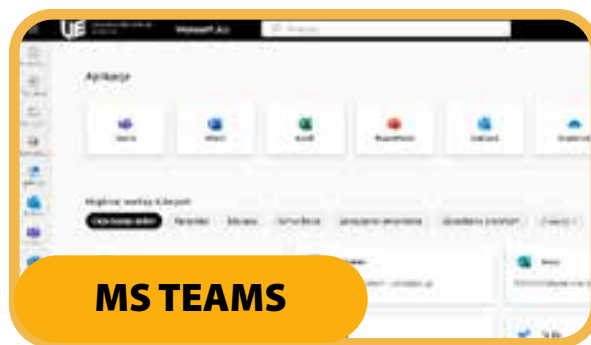

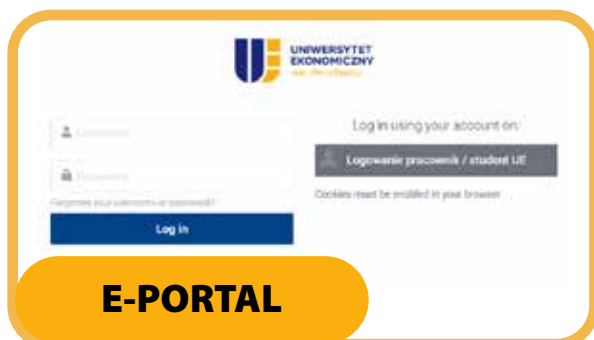


## E-PORTAL

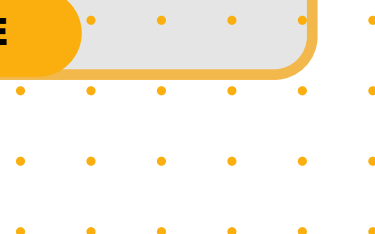
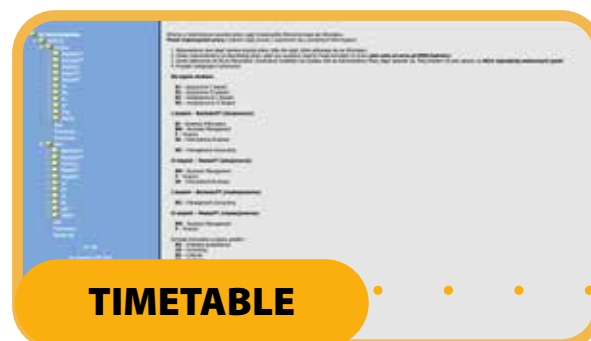


## ONLINE SERVICE OF THE TIMETABLE

## ACADEMIC YEAR

The academic year includes:

- 1) classes resulting from the curriculum,
- 2) two examination sessions lasting a total of not less than six weeks; each session consists of a main and resit session,
- 3) breaks of a total duration of not less than six weeks, including a summer break of at least four weeks.

## OBLIGATORY CLASSES

It is the duty of every student to participate in compulsory classes:

- 1) tutorials,
- 2) computer classes,
- 3) laboratories,
- 4) foreign language classes,
- 5) seminars
- 6) physical education classes

Students are obliged to sit exams at the dates specified by the University.

## NON-OBLIGATORY CLASSES

It is a good academic practice to be present at the lectures.

In the event of absence from mandatory classes, remember to **justify it** (for example with a doctor's note).

Jestem adiunktem na Uniwersytecie Ekonomicznym we Wrocławiu w Katedrze Międzynarodowych Stosunków Gospodarczych. Jestem stypendystą nagrody Fulbright - Schuman Award 2022/2023, dzięki której miałem zaszczyt zrealizować staż badawczy na Uniwersytecie Kalifornijskim w San Diego pod kierunkiem prof. Davida G. Victora w School of Global Policy and Strategy. Pełnię także funkcję członka Sieci Ekspertów Komisji Europejskiej Team Europe Direct gdzie specjalizuje się w obszarze polityk i strategii UE dotyczących transformacji energetycznej i rozwoju niskoemisyjnej gospodarki wodorowej.

Jestem absolwentem Europejskiej Akademii Dyplomatów w Warszawie oraz stypendystą, między innymi, Fundacji im. Kazimierza Pułaskiego oraz Konrad Adenauer Stiftung, a także Narodowej Agencji Wymiany Akademickiej w ramach programu PROM, w ramach której zrealizowałem staż badawczy na Kyushu University (Japonia) w maju 2022. W 2021 roku miałem również zaszczyt wziąć udziału w programie mentoringowym TopMinds, który jest współorganizowany przez Amerykańską Komisję Fulbrighta i Stowarzyszenie Top500 Innovators.

Przed rozpoczęciem badań w ramach studiów doktorskich pracowałem w Przedstawicielstwie Komisji Europejskiej we Wrocławiu. Studowałem Ekonomię na Uniwersytecie Ekonomicznym we Wrocławiu i Universidade do Porto w Portugalii (w ramach programu Erasmus). W 2019 roku ukończyłem Biznesowy Indywidualny Program Studiów na Uniwersytecie Ekonomicznym we Wrocławiu. W trakcie studiów byłem zaangażowany w kształtowanie regionalnej polityki regionalnej, pełniłem funkcję Przewodniczącego Młodzieżowego Sejmiku Województwa Dolnośląskiego oraz stałego reprezentanta w Młodzieżowej Sieci Parlamentów Regionalnych w Zgromadzeniu Regionów Europy (AER).

Obecnie moje zainteresowania naukowe skupiają się wokół zastosowania metody modelowania ekonometrycznego oraz metod ilościowych w badaniu skuteczności polityki na rzecz transformacji energetycznej i alternatywnych źródeł energii – w tym szczególnie w obszarze technologii

## ABOUT WROCLAW

01

Every year in Wrocław, the Night Half Marathon takes place. Runners from all over the world participate in an unforgettable event, covering a distance of 21 km. The race route leads through the most interesting places in Wrocław.

02

The famous Himalayan climber Wanda Rutkiewicz grew up in Wrocław. She was the first Polish woman to reach the summit of Mount Everest and successfully conquered eight out of the fourteen eight-thousanders. A mural depicting her is located on a building in Plac Legionów in Wrocław.

03

In 2006, the Hala Stulecia was placed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. The hall is 42 meters high and its dome has a diameter of 67 meters. Next to the Hala Stulecia you will find the Wrocław Fountain, a multimedia water feature covering the area of one-hectare.

## ABOUT LOWER SILESIA

01

Śnieżka is the highest peak in Lower Silesia, reaching an elevation of 1603.3 meters above sea level. The climate on Śnieżka resembles the conditions found in the polar circle region.

02

Lower Silesia is globally recognized for Bolesławiec Pottery, the origins of which date back to the 15th century. Currently, a significant part of the production is exported to the international market.

03

The oldest castle in Lower Silesia is the Grodziec Castle. Its history dates back to the 11th century. Currently, the castle serves as a tourist attraction, being also a significant element of Lower Silesia's historical heritage.
