# WUEB Library



## ✓ **Main Library**

The WUEB Library is one of the most advanced academic libraries in Lower Silesia. It offers:

- Access to thousands of academic journals, e-books, and databases (e.g. EBSCO, Elsevier, JSTOR),
- Quiet and group study zones,
- Multimedia and computer rooms,
- Extended opening hours during exam periods,
- Professional librarian support in English.

We invite you to register at the Library and obtain **Guest status**, which allows full access to on-site resources (except for borrowing books).

Guests without a University electronic ID can receive a **User Card**, which is free of charge if returned to the Circulation Desk before departure.

We also encourage **a short Library tour to explore its facilities.**

# *Food & Relaxation*

**Need a break? There are several great spots around the campus.**



**The canteen** on the WUEB campus is located in **Building D**, where you can enjoy a good meal or a light snack, have a coffee, or relax in comfortable seating.



Across the University campus, **vending machines offering snacks and coffee** are available in several locations (Buildings A, Z, P, E, and W/U).

Fresh food vending machines (**Freshpod**) are also available in Buildings Z and E.

Additionally, there are **several grocery stores nearby**, including Żabka, Kaufland, and Biedronka, all within a few minutes' walking distance from the campus.





The University offers a **chillout room in building W/U** where students and staff can relax. The space includes comfortable seating, table football, and charging points for mobile phones.

Each building offers **comfortable seating areas** where you can sit and relax in a quiet atmosphere.



The library provides **plenty of spaces**, including some cosy spots hidden among the bookshelves.

Date	Event	Description
March 10-11	<b>Vampiriada</b>	A charity project promoting a healthy lifestyle, blood donation, and helping others. The finale takes place on the campus (or in a mobile blood donation bus), and every donor receives a special gift package.
March 14-15	<b>Traveler's Days</b>	A recurring event featuring inspiring talks by renowned travelers. Attendees can hear amazing stories from around the world, gain practical travel tips, and connect with fellow travel enthusiasts. It's the largest festival of its kind in Wrocław, attracting hundreds each year.
March 28	<b>Wrocław E-Sport Tournaments</b>	A competitive e-sports event featuring team tournaments in Counter-Strike: Global Offensive and League of Legends. The project aims to raise awareness about the rapidly growing e-sports industry.
May 4-8	<b>International Teaching Week</b>	An event supporting international exchange of teaching and research experiences, promoting collaboration between partner universities. It showcases innovative teaching methods, allows faculty to build academic connections, and lets students expand their skills in an international environment. Registration is required to participate.
May 21	<b>FIFA Tournament</b>	A biannual entertainment event for FIFA fans, gathering around 70 players to compete in football matches.

Date	Event	Description
May 26-27	<b>Animals Charity Project</b>	A charity initiative raising funds for selected shelters and foundations in Wrocław. The project features concerts, parties, karaoke, and other fun events to support a good cause.
May 29-31	<b>Juwenalia Wrocław 2026</b>	The biggest student festival in Wrocław, featuring concerts, dance areas, contests, food, and lots of fun. Everyone is welcome to join the celebration and enjoy the vibrant student atmosphere.
May 31	<b>Wrocław Academic Run</b>	A charity running event with distances of 2.5 km, 5 km, and 10 km through Grabiszyński Park. Participants enjoy a warm-up session, an activity zone with attractions, and awards for top runners. All proceeds from entry fees and donations go to a chosen beneficiary.
June 23-24	<b>Vampiriada</b>	A charity project promoting a healthy lifestyle, blood donation, and helping others. The finale takes place on the campus (or in a mobile blood donation bus), and every donor receives a special gift package.
November 19	<b>Integration Day 4</b>	A gathering for the entire academic community aimed at fostering integration and active participation. The event has an international character and welcomes all students and staff.
